

Chris Draper is Head of Animal Welfare and Captivity at the [Born Free Foundation](#). He studied zoology and primatology before starting work in animal protection. After exposure to the reality of animals in zoos, circuses and pseudo-sanctuaries, his career has involved investigation and research into the welfare of wild animals exploited in captivity.
