

Information for Submitting Articles to Specialty & Non-Flagship Law Journals

The following charts list student-run specialty law journals (also called secondary journals and non-flagship journals) in the United States at ABA Accredited Law Schools by category. Inside each line is information on (1) how to submit, (2) submission requirements and formatting requirements, (3) whether student submissions are accepted, and (4) any additional non-article publishing options they offer (blogs, online editions, etc.). As a general rule, the vast majority of law journals in the United States follow the Bluebook and the Chicago Manual of Style and require the above the line text to be double-spaced in point 12 Times New Roman font and the footnotes to be in point 10 Times New Roman font. The vast majority of law journals also require the submission of a curriculum vitae listing your prior and forthcoming publications along with your article.

This list only includes active law journals. Several law schools still honor their former or inactive law journals by including them on their pages, but they are not listed here as they no longer accept submissions or publish. In addition, peer-reviewed law journals that have student editor boards are included, even though the submissions process is different from that of a traditional law review.

Please note that flagship law reviews are not included in these charts. A helpful article with similar information on flagship law reviews has been regularly updated by Allen Rostron and Nancy Levit since 2009 (https://papers.ssrn.com/sol3/papers.cfm?abstract_id=1019029). However, until now, a similar chart has not existed for the hundreds of specialty law journals. I hope that the following pages will fill this long-standing void.

For a list of all active law journals, you used to be able to refer to Washburn University School of Law's list (<http://www.washlaw.edu/lawjournal/>), but this list has not been updated since June 1, 2019. The old website is still active, however, and includes foreign and non-law school publications as well.

A list of some online publication options through traditional law reviews and law journals is maintained on the Legal Scholarship Blog (<http://www.legalscholarshipblog.com/law-review-companions/>), but it does not list all of the online options existing for different journals.

For understanding how these journals are ranked and considered by legal academics, please refer to the overall flagship law journal rankings from US News (https://taxprof.typepad.com/taxprof_blog/2020/07/2020-meta-ranking-of-flagship-us-law-reviews.html) and

Washington & Lee's rankings of all law journals (<https://managementtools4.wlu.edu/LawJournals/>). For convenience, the law journals are broken up into the following categories. Inside each category, the journals are listed in alphabetical order based on the name of the institution at which the journal is based. The word "university" is omitted for the purposes of alphabetization (UC Davis, UC Irvine, and UCLA are both listed under "California," while USC is listed under "Southern California"). Please note that some journals encompass two or more categories but are only listed once in this document:
